







Soil Types

Forest Soil Group IA: best suited for high quality sugar maple, white ash, yellow birch, red oak

-  Haven very fine sandy loam
-  Marlow stony loam
-  Peru stony loam

Forest Soil Group IB: best suited for white birch, red oak

-  Monadnock fine sandy loam
-  Monadnock stony fine sandy loam
-  Monadnock-Lyman stony fine sandy loams


Forest Soil Group IC: best suited for white pine

-  Conton sandy loam

Forest Soil Group IIA: steep or rocky

Forest Soil Group IIB: best suite for spruce, fir

-  Lyman-Moosilauke stony loams

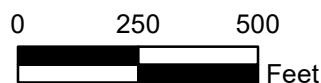
