On January 30, 2022, Investigators from the New Hampshire Attorney General's Office Drug Task Force, with the assistance of the New Hampshire State Police, Claremont Police Department, and the Drug Enforcement Agency made two arrests following a ten-month long investigation. Investigator's learned that two individuals, Katrina Therrien and Christopher Parrott, were distributing large amounts of heroin/fentanyl in the Sullivan County area. The New Hampshire Attorney general's office Drug Task Force obtained arrest warrants for Therrien and Parrott as a result of their on-going investigation.

Following their arrests, search warrants were executed on a vehicle Parrott and Therrien had been driving, and their residence in Claremont NH. Recovered from these search warrants was a large amount of suspected fentanyl, crack cocaine, packaging materials, and united states currency. The total amount of suspected fentanyl was the equivalent of approximately 15,000 individual doses and a street value of approximately \$80,000.00. Over \$17,000.00 cash was seized from the profit of these illicit drug sales.

The two individuals were housed at the Sullivan County House of Corrections. Therrien was held on preventative detention and Parrott was held on \$50,000.00 cash bail.

This investigation is still active and more arrests are anticipated in the near future.
